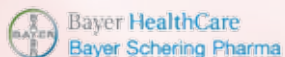

The third **Red Run Classic** is a fundraising walk/run for Haemophilia Foundation Australia and Haemophilia Foundation Queensland.

Join hundreds of other women, men, teenagers and children to have fun while raising money for a

good cause. If you are a serious competitor make the Red Run Classic one of your big events, or just come to walk with your family and friends for a great activity and have fun.

For the first time we are offering two distance routes – 5km and 10km. Both distances will start and end at New Farm Park.



Haemophilia is incurable and without proper treatment, can be life threatening. It is a blood clotting disorder in which one of the essential clotting factors (factor VIII or IX) is deficient.

Haemophilia is hereditary, but in one third of cases it suddenly appears in families with no previous history of the disorder. It affects males almost exclusively and is passed on through females who carry the defective gene. Some women are symptomatic carriers of the haemophilia gene and may also experience bleeding problems. In Australia there are around 3,500 people with haemophilia, von Willebrand disorder or other related inherited bleeding disorders.

Haemophilia Foundations provide programs, service and support to people with haemophilia and their families. All monies from the event are donated to Haemophilia Foundation Australia and Haemophilia Foundation Queensland.
