

World Haemophilia Day 2021

Every year on 17 April World Hemophilia
Day is recognised worldwide to increase
awareness of haemophilia, von Willebrand
disease and other inherited bleeding
disorders. This is a critical effort since with
increased awareness comes better
diagnosis and access to care for the millions
who remain without treatment.

World Hemophilia Day was started in 1989 by the World Federation of Hemophilia (WFH), which chose 17 April as the day to bring the community together in honour of WFH founder Frank Schnabel's birthday.

This year the theme is **Adapting to Change**. Living during a pandemic can pose many challenges, not only for our health, but also for our mental health and wellbeing. In 2021 World Hemophilia Day is a platform across the globe for exploring our community's resilience and how we will overcome this new challenge - as we have overcome other challenges in the past.



Rare is many. Rare is strong. Rare is proud.


HFA has showcased a personal story by Belinda.
